Please Note:

- **Catechumens** are the unbaptized coming into the Church.
- **Candidates** are those who were baptized in a different Christian faith and are coming into the Church or those being fully initiated (Not adult confirmation candidates).
- Guests are only the people invited by the catechumen or candidate (maximum of 2), not to be a general invitation to other parishioners or groups.
- Please do not assume each catechumen/candidate will bring 2 guests—ask them if they plan to invite guests and if so, will it be 1 or 2 guest (s).
- Each parish/community that will participate in the Rite of Election, shall assign one person, (Pastor, Deacon, RCIA Coordinator or other RCIA parish team member) to be the designated Book Bearer during the ceremony.
